(1) Bleach-cleanable as designated by fabric manufacturer. I.E. Carnegie Xorel is a common fabric that is bleach-cleanable.

Guidance:

- Always apply any cleaning methods to a small area first to test effectiveness and result.
- Always use a minimal amount of cleaning solution and use a damp cloth to remove any access soap or cleaning solution; otherwise, it will collect dust and dirt.
 - Soap 5% soap to water ratio
 - Bleach 10:1 water-to-bleach dilution ratio
 - Alcohol Composed of two water-soluble chemical compounds, ethyl alcohol and isopropyl alcohol. They should have a concentration of between 60% to 90% in order to be an effective low-level disinfectant.
- We find that Mr Clean Magic Eraser Pads work really real on most coverings, but requires testing prior to full use.
- It is not necessary to remove the panel to perform any face cleaning. Just make sure you hold the panel in place while cleaning to prevent any potential loosening of the mounting hardware.
- When in doubt...don't!
